People living with a disability may have daily support needs, but that doesn't mean you need to fit a rigid schedule. We understand that independence means being able to live on your terms and we will work with you to provide flexible supports around your schedule, not ours.

Our trained and caring disability support workers can assist you with personal care, daily living tasks, support for social, community and daily personal activities in your home or out in the community.

Shared on-site support

We are all unique. That's why we make sure every client receives personalised support that matches their plan and goals.

Shared on-site support requires every resident to contribute towards the shared support costs. You don't need to buy all your supports from us but you will be required to buy a minimum amount of unplanned support hours.

It is important to know the more hours that are purchased from us, the more staff we can have on-site. This will result in better support outcomes for you both individually and collectively.



You have full choice and control around who provides your regular supports. There is no minimum number of planned support hours you need to purchase.

As your on-site shared support provider, staff will always be available to assist you when you need support. Your support workers will get to know you and understand your day to day support needs.

If you wish, you can also purchase an increased level of support from us through your core supports funding as 'planned supports.' We have skilled and available staff that can support you for this.

You might also like to share your support with other residents. If you have shared goals and similar support needs, you can also share your payment.

Greater flexibility to support you

Planned supports may include:

- Meal preparation
- Personal care hygiene, showering, dressing, grooming, medication, manual handling, meal assistance
- Some skills and development training (e.g. public transport training, shopping, learning assistive technology)
- Rehabilitation support assist with implementing personalised programs designed by your health professionals





Unplanned supports

Your Unplanned Shared Support funding allows each resident access to two hours of unplanned supports per day. One hour of supports can be accessed during the day and the second hour counts as your contribution towards shared inactive overnight support.

If you don't have the SDA line item, then you must allocate a minimum of two hours from your core supports.

It's important to note that unplanned supports are just that – unplanned and irregular.

Waiting time

Given that unplanned support time is shared with other residents, you may have to wait up to an hour when you request unplanned support. Unplanned supports can be used to assist with urgent needs and priority will always be given to emergencies.

Additional support

If you need additional support for more than your funded two hours, you're welcome to purchase additional support using your Core Support funding.

What your unplanned supports may include:

- · Help with making a phone call
- Attending an emergency
- Assisting with technology including searching the internet
- Assisting you with domestic tasks around your home like cooking, cleaning and laundry
- Setting up and packing up an activity e.g. painting easel, paints, crafts
- Supporting you with your pet whether you're at home or away from your apartment
- Short outings in the community *

Your funding

Our support requires the following funding:

- Unplanned Shared Support item number: 01_066_0115_1_1 "Unplanned on-site shared supports in Specialist Disability Accommodation". All participants are required to contribute to this funding.
- 2. Planned or additional supports purchased using Core Support funding.
